

- **1.25% School District Income Tax Rate**  
*[5.71 Equivalent Property Tax Millage (2016 valuation)]*
- **Tax is on Earned Income Only;**  
**NOT** on Income for interest, dividends, capital gains, pensions, etc.
- **\$1,967,166 Amount estimated to be generated per year**  
*[Source: Ohio Department of Taxation]*
- **5 years, beginning January 1, 2019, for the purpose of current expenses**  
*[Current Expenses = General Operating Costs including Personnel, Utilities & Supplies]*
- **5 years the Levy is expected to maintain a positive general fund balance**  
*[The current 5 year forecast projects a negative general fund balance in 2019 without passing the levy]*
- **M-P is the only school district in Madison County without a school district income tax**  
*[Jefferson Local 1%, London 1%, Jonathon Alder 1.25%]*
- **M-P has, and will continue to have, the lowest effective tax rate in Madison County**  
*[Madison-Plains 22 mills, London 23 mills, Jonathon Alder 24.95 mills, Jefferson Local 31.45 mills]*
- **M-P has NOT passed or received new operating levy revenue since May 2005 (12+ yrs)**
- **1.5% Average annual expenditure increase over the last 3 years**  
*[1.8% Average annual United States consumer price index increase (inflation) over the last 3 years]*
