### RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 5705.192 of the Ohio Revised Code, this board, by resolution adopted July 3, 2012, has determined the necessity to levy a replacement tax in excess of such ten-mill limitation for the purpose of providing permanent improvements and for the purchase of school buses at the rate not exceeding two and one-half (2.5) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to twenty-five cents (\$0.25) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a period of five (5) years. Said tax is proposed to replace an existing two and one-half (2.5) mill, five (5) year levy for said purpose authorized by a majority the electors of the School District voting on said proposition at an election held on November 6, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to this Board of Education the total tax valuation of the school District and the estimated amount of revenue to be raised annually by the proposed replacement levy.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Madison-Plains Local School District (herein the "School District"), County of Madison, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the board of education hereby determines to proceed with the levy and the question of the adoption of said replacement tax shall be submitted to the electors of the School District at the election to be held on November 6, 2012, and if said replacement tax is approved by a majority of said electors such replacement tax levy shall first be placed upon the 2012 tax list and duplicate, for first collection in calendar year 2013.

SECTION 2. That the form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of the Madison-Plains Local School District **FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SCHOOL BUSES** at a rate not exceeding two and one-half (2.5) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to twenty-five cents (\$0.25) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing tax year 2012, collection year 2013.

SECTION 3. That the treasurer of this board of education be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the board of elections, not later than four o'clock (4:00)

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this board of education concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this board of education; and that all deliberations of this board of education and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. ADOPTED this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2012.
