ANNOUNCEMENTS

Spacing for the processional will be arms length apart. All turns should be sharp and precise.

Be sure to stay in the proper order and in the row assigned.

OPENING REMARKS

Seniors remain standing, boys remove hats in unison for the opening remarks when the student approaches the podium. Class sits in unison after opening remarks (hats should be replaced after student is finished.)

PRESENTATION OF DIPLOMAS

Each row will rise as directed and practiced during rehearsal. After the presentation of diploma to the last person in that row, and that person goes back to their seat, then that row is seated and the next row will stand. After all diplomas have been given, and the last row is seated, the class president will come to the podium for the tassel ceremony. Tassel is moved from the right side to the left side and this will be done in unison and on cue. You will stand for this ceremony. Please refrain from tossing caps, if you do, they are your responsibility.

CLOSING REMARKS

Remain standing for the closing remarks.

RECESSIONAL

Class will leave following the same spacing pattern as practiced.
