For Fiscal Years 2024 and 2025, districts and schools are required to use funding to support the initiatives outlined in the following table. **Districts and schools must use at least 50% of SWSF for mental health services or physical health care services or a combination of both.**

If an initiative is marked with both a green circle and a blue square, either funding source may be used.
